Program Progress...

The FCaMP program is thriving! To date, we have TNR'd 180 campus ferals, have found homes for 60 kitties, and have provided medical services for 27 kitties (who didn't require sterilization). We have spent over \$12,000 on these endeavors. At this point, it is accurate to say that the main campus area has been stabilized, meaning the vast majority of cats have been spayed or neutered.

We have a wonderful group of volunteers who see to it that the campus kitties have food and water seven days a week, 365 days a year! As a result, our kitties are happy and healthy.

Did You Know?

The nose pad of a cat is ridged in a pattern that is unique, just like the fingerprint of a human.

During her productive life, one female cat could have more than 100 kittens.

A single pair of cats *and their kittens* can produce as many as 420,000 kittens in just 7 years.

More than 35,000 kittens are born in the U.S. each year. Spay or neuter your cat.

People who own pets live longer, have less stress, and have fewer heart attacks.

Cats are the sleepest of all mammals. They spend 16 hours of each day sleeping.

Cats spend 30% of their waking hours grooming themselves.

Cats are more aggressive when they are not neutered or spayed.

The New Mexico Spay & Neuter license plate is a reality! The annual cost is \$37 (in addition to normal vehicle registration fees), and \$25 of the money goes into a fund for spay and neuter programs in the county in which the plate was purchased. These programs are badly needed in the state, which has one of the highest euthanasia rates in the country due to pet overpopulation.
